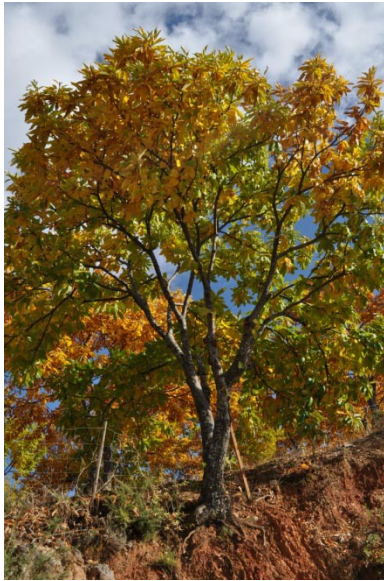


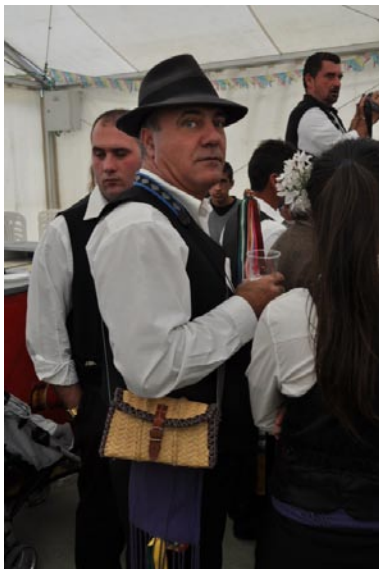
## Rabbit fiesta in Parauta



The little village Parauta is located on the mountain road up to Ronda. From Highway leads a narrow winding road down to the white village situated on a hillside. So here in mid-November, the chestnut trees are beginning to get their yellow and dark red fall colors are beautiful among the dark green olive trees. At the village school playground a marquee has been erected and all around there are stalls in which they sell local products. Here are the typical caps for older women, wine and cheese from nearby villages, cakes, to name a few. It is given the opportunity to taste both the wine, cheese and pastries.

Musicians and dancers dressed in traditional costumes entertain at one end of the tent while the other end is a modern pop band. A glorious mix of music may seem, but the Spanish locals seem to thrive.

There are not many tourists at this festival dedicated to the rabbit - Fiesta del Conejo. In anticipation of the highlight is served portions of pork stew or chorrizo with bread or pomfrites. The whole village and probably also from the neighboring villages are gathered to eat and drink. An opportunity to socialize with everyone in the neighborhood. In a kitchen to one side stands a few chefs and cooking rabbit stew. The highlight of the fiesta is when all visitors are invited to eat the rabbit stew.
